

### **GALACTICA Background & Vision**

- **Textile and aerospace industry** face similar challenges: need for product diversification, new potential applications, innovative business models in cross-sectorial fields
- Advanced manufacturing and digitalization of the sectors are seen as a solution to challenges
- GALACTICA will support the creation of new cross-sectoral and crossborder value chains with a focus on new production processes, development of advanced materials and industry 4.0

### **1**<sup>st</sup> Calls for proposals





### **PIONEER ACCELERATION**

- Applicants: Minimum 1 SMEs from one of the eligible sectors (aerospace, textile, advanced manufacturing) wishing to submit a project idea that connects the above sectors.
- Scope: Exploration new business models on developing a Minimum Viable Product (MVP) connecting two or more GALACTICA sectors
- Indicative supported activities/ideas:
  - Building of the prototype in form of a Minimum Viable Product
  - Testing of the hypothesis with business measurements and user validation tests
  - Adjusting the product/service with a dedicated learning process
- Duration: 4 months project
- Maximum grant per voucher: **20k per project**
- 1<sup>st</sup> call Total budget: 400 k
- Number of expected funded projects: 20 projects in the 1st call
- Deadline: 19<sup>th</sup> May 2021 at 17.00 CEST (Brussels Time)

#### CONCEPT VALIDATION

Reach your MVP and validate your business concept



### **ORBITAL PROJECTS**

- Applicants: Minimum 2 SMEs from 2 different sectors
- Scope: implementation of functional prototypes and demonstrators for new crosssectoral value chains, connecting two or more of the sectors
- Indicative supported activities/ideas:
  - Experimentation
  - Technological maturation
  - Prototype/system integration design and development, including materials, technical testing and market testing
  - Standardisation
- Duration: 6 months project
- Maximum grant per project: 100.000€, with a maximum 58.000€ per SME
- 1<sup>st</sup> call total budget: 800 k
- Number of expected funded projects: 8 projects in the 1st call
- Deadline: 19<sup>th</sup> May 2021 at 17.00 CEST (Brussels Time)



**BUILDING & DEMONSTRATION** 

Make and test a functional product in the market



### **Eligibility conditions**

- SME in accordance with the <u>SME definition of the European Union</u> Staff headcount: < 250 persons; turnover: < 50 M€; balance sheet total < 43 M€</li>
- 2. SMEs established or with a branch office in one of the 27 EU member states or UK
- 3. Linked SMEs from other countries will not be considered as a cross border value chain.
- 4. Applications must be written in **English**
- 5. For Pioneer Vouchers SMEs can **apply** alone or in consortium. For Orbital Vouchers only consortia of at least 2 SMEs from different sectors will be eligible.
- 6. SMEs applying to the call as a consortium should fill in one proposal.
- 7. The **maximum amount to be granted per SME** by GALACTICA project shall not exceed €60.000,00 in total even in the case of multiple granted voucher scheme types to the SME during the lifetime of GALACTICA(excluding hackathon prices)
- 8. One SME can apply to one or more voucher scheme respecting this limit
- 9. Applications must be submitted through the <u>web-based system</u> by 17:00 CEST (Brussels time) of the 19th May 2021



### **Eligible costs**

- Only costs generated during the lifetime of the project
- SMEs internal costs:
  - Direct staff costs
  - Other direct costs: travel costs, equipment, consumables, etc.
  - Indirect costs: A flat rate of 25% of the direct eligible costs
- **Subcontracting costs** such as expert services by Research Technology Organization (RTO), Universities, Research Institutes, living labs and similar, large companies, etc.
  - Subcontracting may cover only a limited part of the action. Beneficiary must justify it properly.



# Evaluation criteria and scoring mechanism

## The eligible proposals will be evaluated by independent experts and ranked according 3 criteria:

- Excellence
- Implementation
- Impact

#### Each sub-criteria will be rated between 1-5 points

- Individual Threshold =3
- Overall Threshold =70

Cross border value chains will be positivelly evaluated

### **Open call for experts evaluators**

- We search for experienced evaluators and/or entrepreneurship experts of at least five years of experience in some of the following areas, within the TEXTILE, AEROSPACE, ADVANCED MANUFACTURING/ICT, INNOVATION
- Experts can be from all 27 EU countries or UK.
- Evaluators will be asked to declare potential conflict of interest in a specific voucher scheme. i.e: a RTO involved as subcontractor in an Orbital proposal could only evaluate Pioneer proposals, and viceversa

### **Monitoring and reporting**


- Beneficiaries will be assigned a technical reviewer from GALACTICA consortium
- Overall **performance progress report** and **deliverables** submitted one month after the end of the project
- The final technical evaluation will assess the **coherence of the money spent with the achieved results**





### **Payment terms**

- Pioneer acceleration. Lump sum up to 20.000€
- Orbital projects. Lump sum up to 100.000 €
- Both vouchers have 2 instalments:
  - Pre- financing: within 30 days from contract signature (50%)
  - Final: within 30 days from the completion of the assessment of the final progress performance report (50%)
- Payments will be made to each SME of the consortium based on their budget
- GALACTICA "Beneficiaries" must ensure that the European Commission, the European Anti-fraud Office (OLAF) and the Court of Auditors (ECA) can exercise their powers of control and audit





### **Coaching for beneficiaries**

- 1. Pioneer beneficiaries will be supported with 20h of coaching from the consortium.
  - Market research; Financial planning; Business modeling; Perfecting pitch; IP strategy; Space related technology transfer
- 2. Orbital projects beneficiaries will receive 50 h coaching from the consortium.
  - Project management methodologies; Prototyping and innovation management; Growth strategies; Financing and funding strategies

The support will continue in the form of coaching for scale-up after the funded project ends:

- leverage funding with other sources
- financing, funding and capital-raising strategies

- Opening date for the proposal submission for Pioneer and Orbital: 16<sup>th</sup> March 2021
- Closing date for the proposal submission for Pioneer and Orbital: 19<sup>th</sup> May 2021 at 17h CEST
- Evaluation period: May-June 2021
- Notification of funded proposals: July 2021
- Contract signature: July-August 2021
- Expected starting date of the projects: 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021
